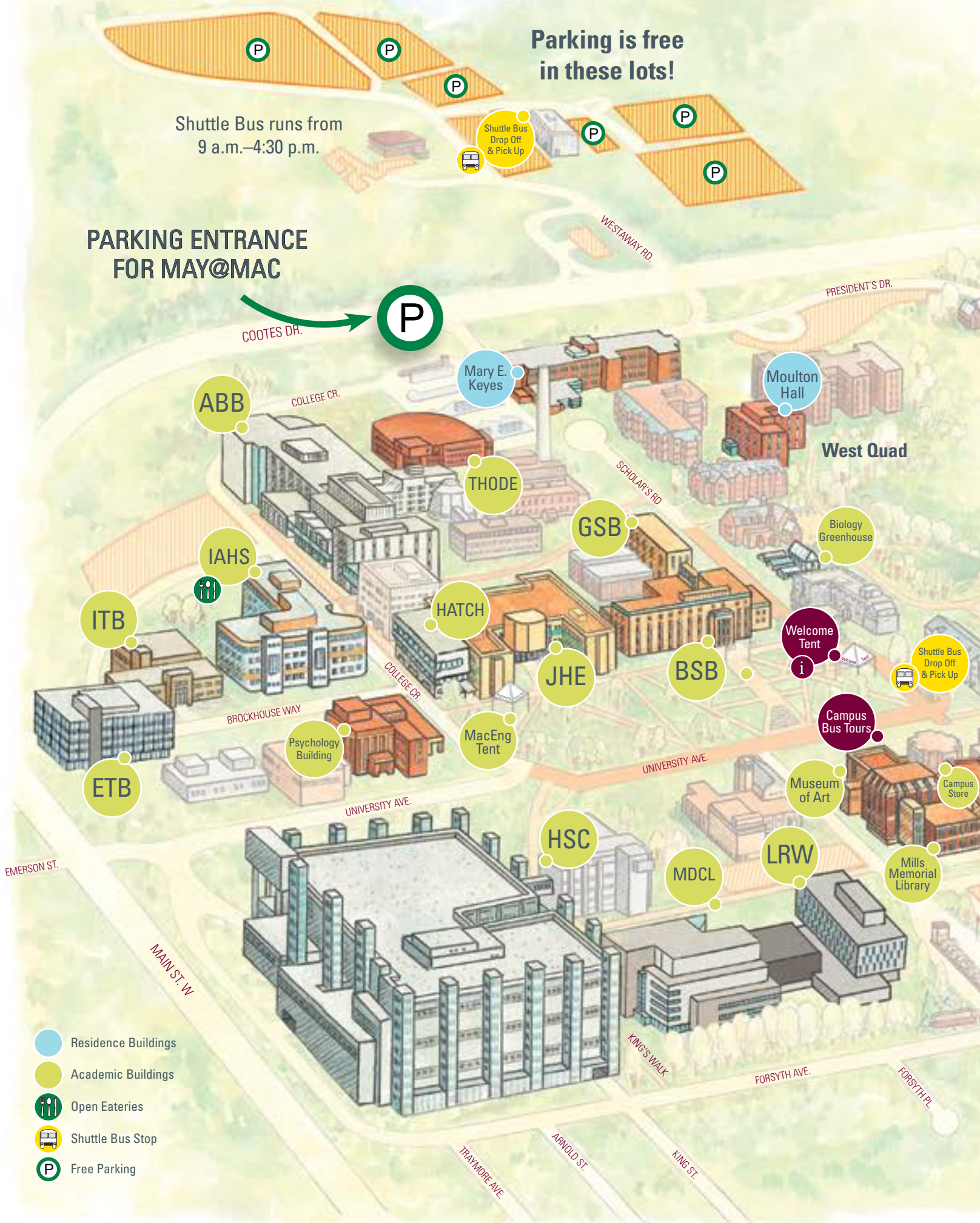

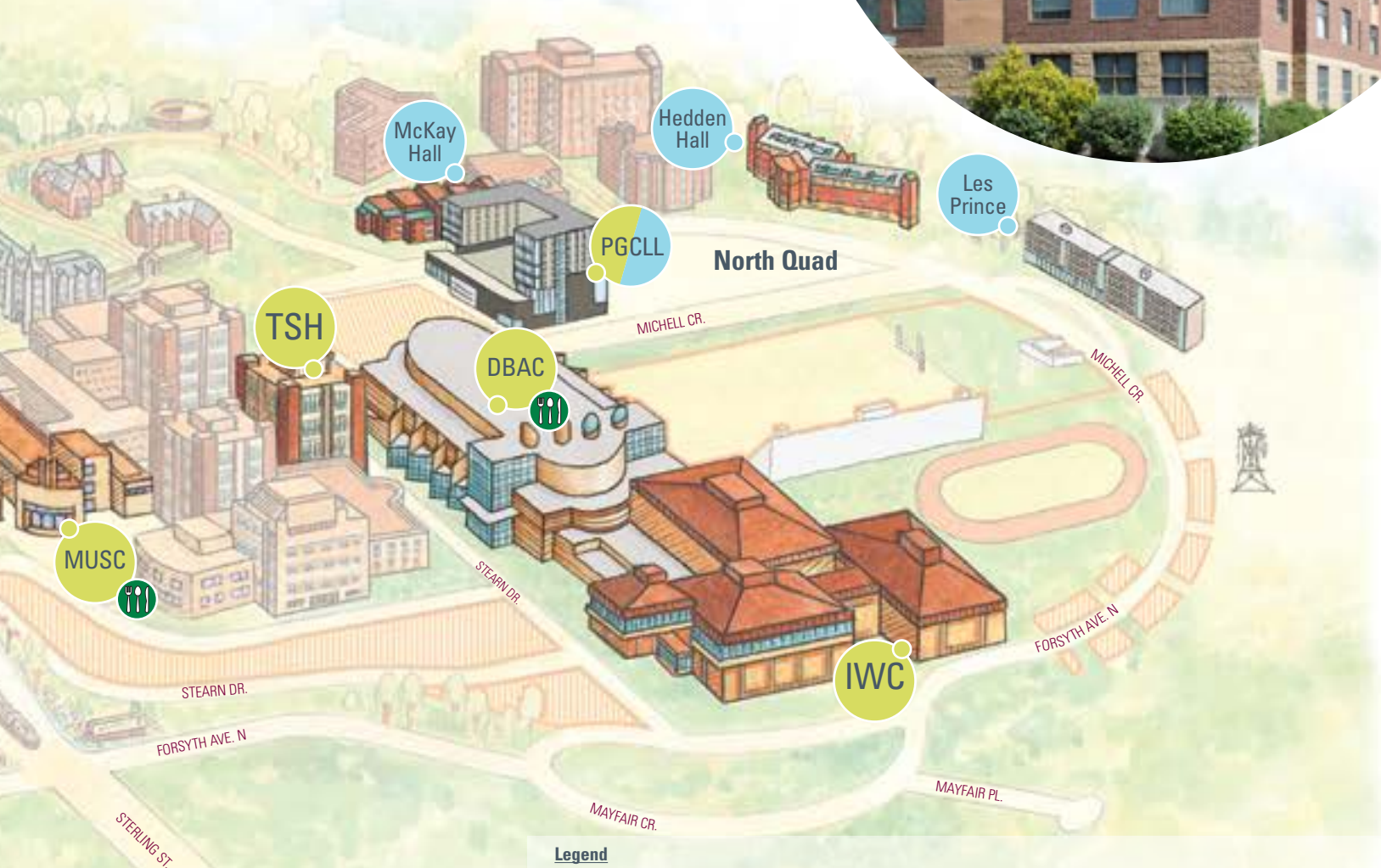
RESIDENCE TOURS

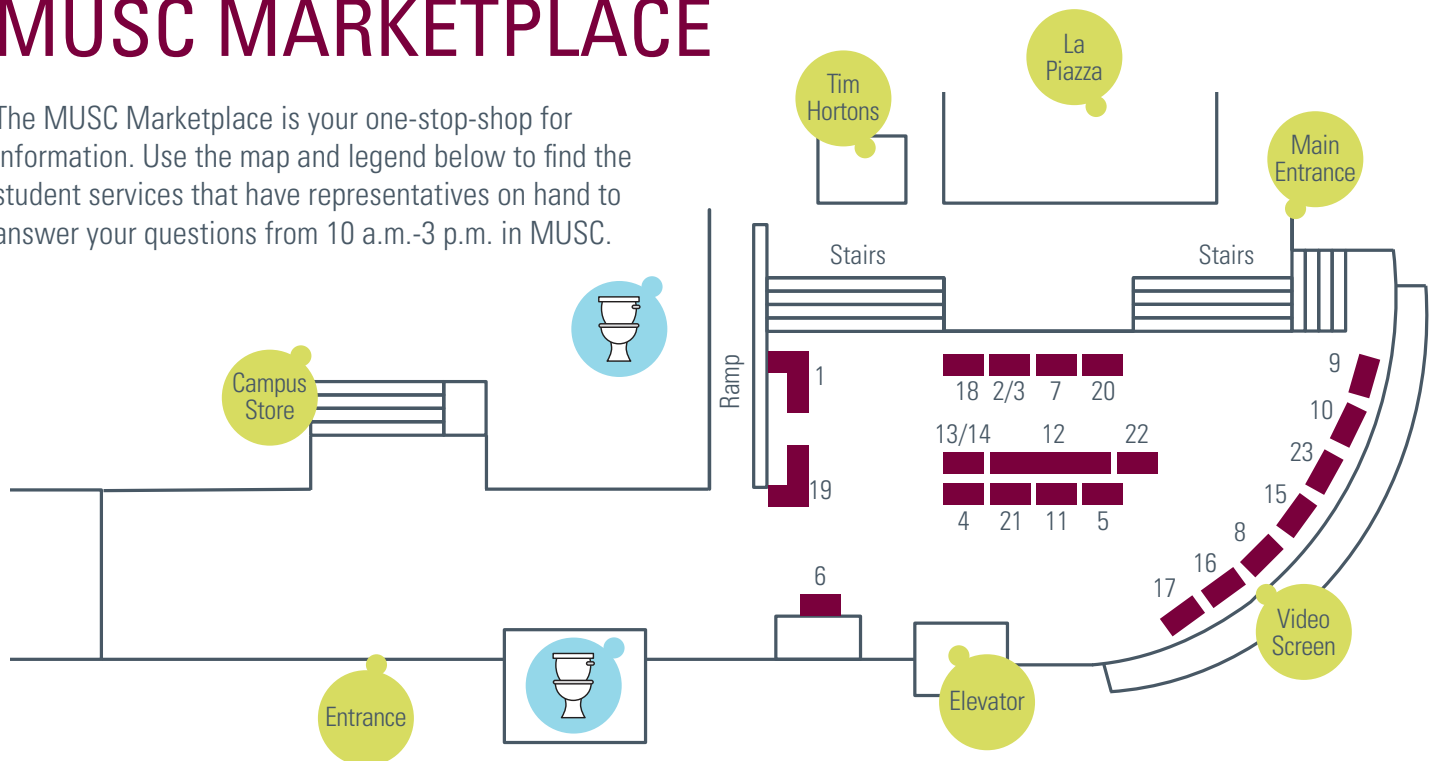

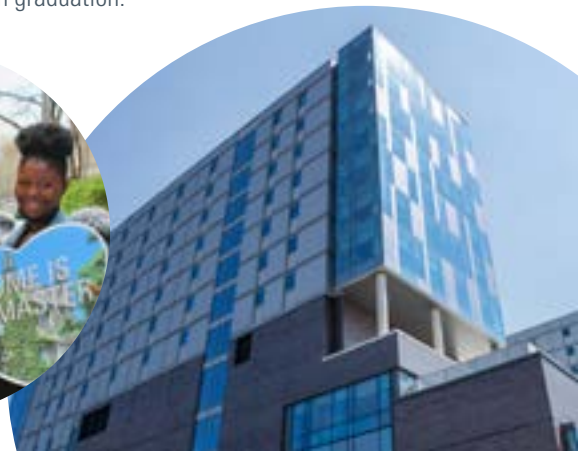
